WHEREAS, the City of Chamblee is authorized by the Constitution of the State of Georgia to adopt traffic regulations, rules and orders, including, but not limited to, regulation of speed limits and speed zones with respect to the operation of motor vehicles on the public ways of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has adopted ordinances codified in the City Code as Article II, Chapter 86, “Traffic and Vehicles” which ordinances provide that the governing authority of the City may, by ordinance or resolution, approve and authorize the police chief, or a designee thereof, to designate and maintain with appropriate traffic control signs, markings and devices speed zones, traffic rules, regulations and orders for any other signs, markings or zones necessary for the orderly and safe conditions on the streets of the City; and

WHEREAS, Article II, Chapter 86, “Traffic and Vehicles” further provides that there shall be maintained for public inspection in the office of the City Clerk a schedule of all traffic rules, regulations and orders as set forth in subsection (a) of

Section 86-36 of the Code of Ordinances of the City and such rules, regulations and orders shall be incorporated by reference into Article II, Chapter 86; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHAMBLEE, GEORGIA, and it is hereby resolved by authority of the same that in:

O.C.G.A. 40-6-188 Highway Work Zones; reduction in speed; signage (b) (1) states any municipality may designate any segment of a highway, road, or street under its jurisdiction as a Highway Work Zone. The governing authority of any county or municipal corporation is authorized to establish a temporary reduction in the maximum speed limit through any Highway Work Zone located on or adjacent to any street or highway under its respective jurisdiction.

The Chief of Police along with the Public Work Director are designating a temporary reduction of the speed limit during the final construction of the Chamblee Dunwoody Streetscape Project. A reduction from 35 mph to 25 mph on Chamblee Dunwoody Road between Harts Mill Road and Peachtree Boulevard is ordered to improve the safety of everyone in the area. Appropriate warning signage will be erected pursuant this code section until such time the site is no longer under construction requiring the speed reduction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this change shall be effective as of the date set forth below, and that the originals of such exhibits and schedule of traffic rules, regulations & orders shall be maintained in the office of the City Clerk for public inspection.
